- Struggling with reading and writing skills, or no interest in reading.
- Not passing standardized fluency tests or state-mandated screeners.
- Qualified for *early access* or *early childhood services* and may or may not have a medical, or diagnosed condition.
- Family history of dyslexia, reading/writing struggles, or a student history of receptive/expressive speech and language delay. Includes late talkers who experienced phonological speech delays, or have been diagnosed with Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS).
